

Senior Call Check

Senior Call Check is a free service that provides telephone check-ins for MD residents, age 65 and older. Participants receive an automated phone call once a day, in an hour they pre-schedule. If the participant does not answer the first call, they will be tried two more times. If all go unanswered, additional calls will be made to notify a relative, friend, or neighbor who was selected by the participant during the program enrollment.
